## Leadership and Management Program

### COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to introduce health care providers to the theory and methods of teams by integrating the professional and leadership disciplines.

The major components of the course include:

- Building effective teams
- Team decision-making
- Team performance
- Leadership and teams
- Teams and information technology
- Application of theory and principles to the workplace

### COURSE OBJECTIVES

To provide students with:

- An introduction to the types and structure of teams in health care organizations
- An opportunity to study the internal dynamics impacting teams
- An opportunity to study the external dynamics impacting teams
- An opportunity to explore and apply team processes within the workplace
- An opportunity to apply principles of leadership in health care teams
- An awareness of the impact that information technology has on teams

### COURSE FORMAT

Five written assignments are to be completed over a 6 month period. Assignments are graded through the use of a standard procedure by an assigned educational consultant. The consultant is also available for assistance throughout the course.

Successful completion of all components leads to 3 units of University credit.
